Welcome to Zurich



The City Police (Stadtpolizei) welcomes you to Zurich. This guide contains all relevant information you need to make your stay in Zurich a pleasant one.

Game Day in Zurich on Thursday 27th October 2022

The Zurich city police recommend that fans from FK Bodø/Glimt spend the afternoon in the old town. The "Hirschenplatz" (square) and its surroundings are a suitable meeting place. There are several restaurants and pubs around.


At approximately 5 pm two extra buses will then be available for the transfer to the stadium. In addition, tram line no. 4 leads to the "Toni-Areal" stop from where you can get directly to the stadium's guest sector.

Fan retention

To ensure that the various fans can leave the stadium in a safe and orderly manner, you can leave the stadium at the earliest 20 minutes after the end of the match. The beverage and food stands will remain open during that time.

Use of pyrotechnics

The use of pyrotechnics is prohibited by law in Switzerland. The ignition of pyrotechnics poses a serious risk to physical integrity and is classified as an offence against the Explosives Act, i.e. a criminal offence. The commission of criminal offences can lead to deprivation of liberty and police custody.



Covering

In Zurich it is forbidden to make one's face unrecognizable.

Entry requirements

Make sure to check in advance which identity documents are required for Switzerland. In the event of a police check, you will have to be able to identify yourself at any time. At www.ch.ch/en you can check which travel documents are required to enter Switzerland.

Alcohol consumption in road traffic

In Switzerland, vehicle drivers are fined for a blood alcohol concentration of 0.50% or more or a breath alcohol concentration of 0.25 mg/l or more. A complete ban on driving under the influence of alcohol applies to professional drivers.

Narcotics

Violations of the Narcotics Act are punished by a fine and/or a custodial sentence (imprisonment), depending on the quantity and type of narcotics. Spirits, alcopops and distilled water may only be consumed from the age of 18.

Medical care

Medical care is guaranteed. The European Health Insurance Card must be presented for medical and hospital treatment.
